Collections

I am taking most of the photographs that I am accessioning and I am working with another photographer personally and we already have an agreement that will be put into paper. Again I do not think my interpretation of the pieces will be an issue.

Compliance with Law

I should not have any copyright infringements because most of the pieces will be mine. I will also comply with trespassing laws by not entering properties and abide by the creative commons permissions of each individual photographer.
